Electronic Warfare and Unmanned Systems in the digital battlespace

Electronic Warfare is a critical combat enabler: it enhances both survivability and the delivery of combat effects. The ADF is investing heavily in EW self-protection and attack capabilities for its new platforms and a careful selection of legacy platforms.

The role of uninhabited platforms will also play a crucial role in the EW space and *ADM* will examine the options as Australia looks towards their capability across the air, land and underwater environments. The concept of manned/unmanned teaming will also be explored as the ADF seeks to leverage the opportunities offered by unmanned technology.

Cyber Security

Defence plays a critical role in the wider cyber security landscape and *ADM* will explore how Defence, as part of a whole of government approach, and defence industry can work together in this space in the wake of the upcoming Defence Cyber Strategy which is soon to be released.
