Army's Contribution to Defence Strategy describes how Army's teams contribute to the achievement of Strategic Defence Objectives for a safe, secure and prosperous Australia. Army's teams have always adapted to new challenges but are now experiencing changes to the character of warfare at a rate faster than many of Army's processes and structures were designed for. It must be effective during conflict and aim to be as efficient as practicable during cooperation and training in Australia. The system must be digitised, scalable, protected, agile, resilient, integrated to function across the spectrum of conflict in a range of environments. The

system must be survivable in both environments of electronic and physical threat. The LFSS environment encompasses the CIS network, the capability systems and command and control.
