The new helicopter will be optimised for operations within dense urban environments which will allow it to complement the existing MRH90 Taipan and enhance the output of the combined formation. The rapid deployability of the helicopter will provide new options for government to quickly respond to terrorist and hostage situations within domestic Australia and the near region.

The Defence White Paper (DWP) and the Defence Integrated Investment Program (IIP) identified that the Tiger Armed Reconnaissance Helicopter (ARH) would be replaced by a future armed reconnaissance capability from the mid-2020s. The project identified to conduct the replacement is LAND 4503 ARH Replacement. The new capability will replace the Shadow 200 capability and is intended to provide greater performance with respect to; payload modularity, endurance, deployability, connectivity, lethality and interoperability. The TUAS will be operated by 20 Surveillance and Target Acquisition Regiment which will grow from two TUAS batteries to three.
