Small Business Innovation Research for Defence (SBIRD) is a program encouraging Australian Small-to-Medium Enterprises (SMEs) (including University start ups) to undertake research projects under the Next Generation Technologies Fund (Next Gen Tech Fund) in the following topic.

The Australian Defence Force uses remotely piloted fixed wing aircraft for some tactical surveillance operations. When deployed over a surveillance area, the aircraft is vulnerable to visual and acoustic detection from the target areas on the ground. The aircraft is silhouetted against the sky, which varies in luminance and colour, therefore a single colour of coating may not minimise detection in all situations. Similarly, the acoustic noise generated by the aircraft may alert a surveillance target prior to its visual observability. Novel solutions are sought that can:

1. adapt to changing conditions to reduce the visual detectability against a sky background; and/or
2. reduce/change the acoustic signature of these small aircrafts to make them less acoustically detectable in different environmental conditions.

Proposals will be required to describe projects that demonstrate a proposed idea/technology has real viability to function, while scoped around what is achievable within a maximum budget of \$100,000.00 in a timeframe of between 6 - 9 months.

The cloth is currently in service and required in two types:

NSN 8305-66-132-7430 - 100mm wide marked with a red stripe; and NSN 8305-66-139-2251 – 50mm wide marked with a black stripe, for use to clean the two different barrel sizes. The cloth is used to both apply and remove cleaner, lubricant and preservative to the barrel bores and is used for more general cleaning; and has specified levels of absorbency. The colour stripes are spaced such that the correct length required to clean inside each size bore can easily be determined.

Rather than incur the cost of testing large quantities of non-compliant product, it is proposed that tenders provide evidence of compliance with the specification from an independent nationally or internationally recognised test facility, such as National Association of Testing Authorities (NATA) with each tender.
