

GUIDED WEAPONS

Following the announcement that precision guided munitions, hypersonic weapons, and integrated air and missile defence systems are a new Sovereign Industrial Capability Priority, *ADM* will delve into Australia's efforts to create a sovereign guided weapons capability - including the Sovereign Guided Weapons and Explosive Ordnance Enterprise, which will provide the 'enabling ecosystem' to support Defence's inventory of guided weapons and explosive ordnance.

ELECTRONIC WARFARE AND CYBER SECURITY

This month's edition will also include ADM's annual feature on electronic warfare (EW) and cyber security, in support of the MilCIS conference on 22-24 February on military communications and information systems.
